Success by Six (Preschool Scholarships & Transportation)

- Preschool tuition assistance and transportation for families dealing with cost and transportation barriers.
- 200+ preschoolers receive scholarships and/or transportation annually.

Backpack Program (Food)

- Weekend, holiday, and summer food for students who receive free and reduced-price lunches.
- 1,000+ K-12 students receive food bags weekly.

Success Closet (Winter Wear and Personal Care)

- Clothing, winter gear, and personal care items distributed to community members and families in need.
- 500+ individuals receive Success Closet items annually.

2-1-1 (Resource Helpline)

- Free and confidential health and human services referrals provided via phone 24/7.
- 150+ Mower County residents call for help annually and benefit from a nearly 100% referral rate.

Get Connected (Volunteer Center)

- Online volunteer platform connecting those who need help with those who can help through service.
- Over 88,000 volunteer hours logged by community members since 2018 (\$2.5M+ impact value).

Hometown Food Security Project (Community Coalition)

- Collaboration between Hormel Foods, United Way, and other community organizations with the mission to eliminate hunger in Mower County.
- Engaging dozens of partners, mobilizing thousands of pounds of food and hundreds of volunteers, and connecting countless community members to invaluable resources.

United for A.L.I.C.E (Data Center)

- A.L.I.C.E. stands for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed—households that earn above the poverty level but still struggle to afford basic needs like housing, child care, food, and transportation.
- United Way supports A.L.I.C.E. families by investing in programs and partnerships that promote financial stability, access to resources, and long-term resilience.
