“ First grader Parker was struggling in reading. His tutor began working with him and quickly realized that he was disinterested and had no confidence in his reading ability. She would send home the family engagement activities, which encourages students to keep practicing outside of school. After mastering a story during a tutoring session, the student takes it home for additional repeated reading which helps them hone skills and gain confidence.

Unfortunately, Parker had little support at home and rarely had anyone to read to. The tutor reached out to her Internal Coach and Parker’s teacher to arrange time with a reading buddy before school. His teacher volunteered and Parker began reading in the morning right before class started. With this extra practice and his hard work during daily Reading Corps sessions, he blossomed into a confident, independent reader. His reading level was increasing at an amazing rate!
