Mitchell had a cell phone but needed cell phone minutes so employers could contact him, so his Career Planner issued a voucher to cover his minutes for the month. He applied at Lou Rich in AL, interviewed and got

hired after two weeks of job search. When he was hired his Career Planner issued him another voucher to pay for work boots, pants and two shirts. He started on January 2, 2019 making a very good wage!
