“ During COVID, Chad found a job as a dishwasher in a commercial setting and was assisted by Cedar Valley Services to learn the tasks and arrange for his own independent transportation. Chad’s new job involved washing dishes at Culvers. He works four days a week, during the day helping with the lunch rush while maintaining a clean and organized dish room.

Chad had a job coach with him for the first few weeks to help get established and learn a routine.

He uses SMART transit and the taxi service in town to help him get to and from work each day. Chad is now working independently with just follow-up supports twice a month where Cedar Valley checks in with him to help maintain employment status and employer relationships. He has learned to do extra tasks if dishes are caught up, and states that he loves his job at Culvers and the people he works with. ”
